January was a big month for local commercial wineries. Twelve Placer County wineries came together to form the Placer County Vintners Association the same week that the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition concluded its annual week of judging and awarded Placer Wineries 19 medals at the at the prestigious Sonoma County competition. Winners are:

- Lone Buffalo Vineyards, one Gold & one Silver
- Pescatore Vineyards & Winery, one Bronze
- Mt. Vernon Winery, one Gold, one Silver & two Bronze
- Dono dal Cielo, one Silver
- Vina Castellano, three Silver & two Bronze
- Fawnridge Winery, two Bronze
- Duarte Family Vineyards, one Bronze

Off to a bang for 2010, the association also launched a county-wide wine trail and plans to add new events in addition to existing quarterly wine tours throughout the year. The purpose of the new association is to raise awareness of Placer County as a premier wine-producing region, to enhance public recognition of the hand-crafted, award winning wines of Placer County and to promote a positive business environment for the growth and production of Placer County wines and wineries. Although the new association and PCWGA share similar goals, PCVA is an IRC Section 501(c)(6) trade organization, intended to compliment, not replace or compete with, PCWGA, by focusing on the business promotion needs of the commercial wineries. 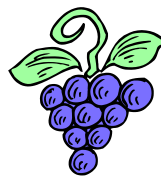
